1999 Tariff Schedule of Charges and Rules

1. RECEIVING: Tagging, weighing on arrival, sampling if requested, issuing warehouse receipts and placing in storage, per bale \$1.85
 - (a) HVI Classing \$1.30
 2. Covering sample holes on bales sampled on arrival (to be billed at end of month). \$1.00
 3. STORAGE AND INSURANCE: Per bale, per month or fraction thereof. \$2.25
 4. COMPRESSION: (A lien for compression may be claimed on cotton received from Standard or Universal Density gin. If so, it will be noted on the face of the receipt) Compression will be collected at time of shipment at tariff (see NOTE A below), per bale \$7.00
 5. SHIPPING: Includes picking out by tag number, removing from storage, marking one line of not more than five characters, and loading to rail, truck or container, per bale. \$7.00
 - (a) Additional marking or branding (five characters), per bale. \$3.40
 6. Additional marking or branding which exceeds five characters, per bale. \$0.50
 7. Rearranging or reworking cotton on truck for any purpose, per bale. \$0.75
 8. DELAYED SHIPPING: If Cotton Trade fails to ship within 5 business days after receipt of complete shipping orders or on the date requested, Cotton Trade will stop storage effective on that date and pay a penalty (one month's storage) to the customer unless Cotton Trade had available for shipment that week 4.5% of its licensed capacity (Rule 3), per bale \$2.25
 9. DELAYED PICK-UP: If cotton is not picked up within 48 hours after shipment is ready and shipper has been notified, a special service charge will be accessed. Storage will continue. Cotton not picked up within ten days after ready date will be returned to stock (Rule 9).
Per bale \$2.25
 10. RESTOCKING: After break-out, orders canceled for any reason or cotton not picked up within ten (10) days after ready date, will be returned to stock, per bale. \$4.25

| 12. | TRANSIT COTTON: Handling compressed cotton for consolidation and reshipment if for immediate shipment, and shipping instructions in our possession prior to arrival, will be received and loaded, per bale. | \$4.00 |
| 13. | TRANSIT STORAGE RATE: A storage rate will be assessed on transit cotton if in our possession for more than five business days, per month | \$2.25 |
| 14. | BLOCK: Lots of 50 to 200 bales. Cotton to be held in block exactly as received (no work shall be done to cotton) and shipped exactly as received. Regular Storage plus handling, per bale | \$4.00 |
| 15. | ELECTRONIC RECEIPTS: | |
| | (a) Conversion from electronic to paper receipt, per bale | \$0.25 |
| | (b) Conversion from paper to electronic receipt, per bale | \$0.25 |

NOTE A: This facility does not operate a compress; therefore, any cotton received flat will be shipped flat, and no attempt will be made to arrange compression with some other facility.
